TALENT TRIBE DANCE FESTIVAL DIVISIONS

FINALS is limited to one division. Please note competitors who have qualified in CHIEF or WARRIOR are eligible to enter. Entries are not limited to the number of routines you qualified in at a regional event – THERE IS NO LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OF ROUTINES YOU CAN ENTER AT FINALS.

TALENT TRIBE DANCE FESTIVAL - STYLES

COMMERCIAL CONTEMPORARY – A routine with the intention of creating popular awareness to popular & current movements used to enhance a more present-day contemporary style.

TRADITIONAL CONTEMPORARY – A routine where the movements have arisen from the tradition of this dance style. Primarily teaching the younger generations the history of this art form.

LYRICAL - A routine that is performed to the lyrics or mood of the music.

- JAZZ A routine that utilizes jazz technique such as splits, isolation, leaps, etc.
 HIP HOP A dance that consists of the latest street dance style, as seen in
 current dance videos.
- **BROADWAY/MUSICAL THEATRE** Any style of dance interpreting a song from Broadway, movie or musical.
- ACROBATICS A routine that contains primarily gymnastic tricks, including, but not limited to walkover, front/back limbers, handstands, headstands, cartwheels, etc. There should be a blend of gymnastics and dance together.
- SONG and DANCE A routine that combines dancing and singing. This is a vocal routine...lead vocals may not be lip synched and may have back up vocal accompaniment only.
- **BALLET: Classical & Demi-Character** A routine consisting of classical steps & ballet technique. Ballet or Pointe shoes must be worn
- **OPEN: Any style** A routine that is a combination of any of the other categories; a routine that does not exactly fit any of the definitions of any other category.
 - **TAP: Fast and slow** A routine utilizing tap technique and must be performed with tap shoes only.
 - **SINGING** competitors showcase vocal abilithy through diction, technique, tone, and musicality.
 - performances are judged on vocals, stage presence and overall connection to the song.
 - **NEO-CLASSICAL** a routine consisting of classical ballet technique with contemporary and modern movements.

AGE GROUPS

Age is determined by the age you were when attending your first Talent Tribe Regional in 2025/26 ie. If you danced in a 12/u section and were 11 years old at the time, you enter the 11 Years section.

Introducing the Pageant at Talent Tribe

Scoring Explanation

Each contestant will receive a Pageant score out of 100 points, judged on poise, presentation, personality, confidence, and communication.

Each contestant also has a Grand Tournament solo score.

The Pageant score is combined with the solo score to create one final tally.

The top three contestants with the highest combined scores will progress to the Grand Tournament Showcase, in their age division.

The top three will walk the stage and perform again in the Grand Tournament Showcase alongside the three highest grand tournaments scoring competitors.

From the Showcase, **one overall winner** will be selected to receive the grand prize — a trip to New York with our National Champions to compete in the World Dance Pageant and World Dance Championships.

Scoring Breakdown (Total: 400 points) - 3 Judges
An addional pageant judge will score the following:
Interview / Communication Skills - 30 points
Stage Presence & Poise - 30 points
Talent Presentation - 40 points
Combined Champion Calculation:
Pageant Score (out of 100)

Grand Tournament Solo Dance Score (out of 300)
= Combine page words 400 points

To be eligible for the Pageant, competitors MUST compete in the Grand Tournament Section.

Competitors must be aged between 8 years and 18 years of age

Attire:

Girls: Must wear an elegant formal dress and appropriate footwear.

(Competitors over 12 years of age must wear a full length gown, competitors under 12 years of age can wear either full or tea length attire.)

Boys: Must wear a blazer, tie and dress slacks or a suit with appropriate footwear.

Stage Presentation:

All contestants must walk the stage with confidence and poise.

Speaking:

Competitors must speak on a microphone. This may include answering a question, giving a brief introduction, or sharing something about themselves.

Scoring Criteria:

Presentation & Attire: 0–35 points
Confidence & Stage Presence: 0–30 points
Speaking & Communication: 0–35 points

General:

Judges' decisions are final.Contestants who fail to follow attire, stage, or speaking requirements may be marked down, in scoring.

TALENT TRIBE RULES AND CONDITIONS

FINALS is limited to one division only.

AGE: Age is determined by the age you qualified at a regional event.

There are no refunds, except if a section or the event is cancelled.

All competitors and spectators enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury, or loss of property. This also applies to cars parked in the grounds of the venue.

All competitors will be required to confirm their attendance with the backstage
Manager. Competitors should arrive at least 30 minutes before their section commences
Adjudicators decision is final. There is to be no communication with the
adjudicator during the competition.

Any section containing more than 20 competitors may be divided into parts A and B depending on the number in attendance on the day.

If insufficient numbers in a section, the organiser reserves the right to amend, combine, or cancel sections at their discretion.

Changes to the running order of the programme will be left to the discretion of the organiser.

Distractions and prompting from the sides of the stage will not be tolerated whilst a competitor is performing - with the exception of the babies dance sections. This will lead to disqualification

Any competitor who has a memory lapse will be able to return to the stage to perform the routine once again for comments only - this is up to the discretion of the organiser.

Members of duos/trios can only dance in one age group with the same partner, but can dance in the same section with a different partner.

Competitors must only enter and compete once in a section. A change of costume or routine does not alter this rule.

No competitor is permitted to wear tap shoes inside the venue except side of stage or on the stage.

This rule will be strictly enforced.

Props must be removed from stage as soon as possible after performance is completed and removed completely from side stage.

Pointe shoes are not to be worn by competitors under 12 years of age.

The use of videos, cameras and mobile phone photography is STRICTLY NOT PERMITTED and may lead to a competitor being disqualified.

Teachers, please advise parents of this restriction. An official photographer and videographer will be available to record your dances for a fee.

All rubbish and items must be removed from the venue and change rooms when you leave.

Please leave change rooms and hall in the clean and tidy condition in which they were found.

No smoking is permitted anywhere on school grounds.

The TALENT TRIBE organiser shall decide on any matter not covered by these rules, and its decision in any question or dispute shall be final. Any rule may be amended at the discretion of the committee.

By entering into the competition, you agree to comply with all the rules laid down by the Committee. Talent Tribe has the right to refuse entry to any competitor or competitor's representative who behaves in an unacceptable manner.

If you are unable to attend a regional due to Covid-19 you will be ineligible to receive a refund or transfer.

If the adjudicator has taught any dance school or competitor a routine they are adjudicating, they are eligible for critiques only – no placings. The Talent Tribe team MUST be notified of this prior to the competitor competing.

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
